The 35th Three Peaks Mountain Race Sunday, 15 April 2018

Weather: Gusty almost gale force winds

There were gale force winds out there, but the participants and helpers were not going to let the conditions deter them. Thanks also to our sponsors for supporting this great event.

26km Mountain Race

Woodhaugh St, Flagstaff, Swampy Summit, Mt Cargill, Chingford Park
Open Men's runner Daniel Balchin won the Three Peaks Mountain race and despite the strong
winds achieved a fast time of 2 hrs 9 mins 14 secs. He was also the winner of the Town Garage
King of the Mountain for being the first male runner to the top of Swampy Summit (58 mins 8 secs)
and to still finish the race. Second was Open Men's runner Jonah Smith in 2:15:27 and third was
Open Men's runner Thomas Spencer in 2:20:29. Fifth across the line was the first MM35-49 runner
Grant Guise in 2:25:35 followed by the second MM35-49 runner Romain Mirosa in 2:27:02. In 14th
individual place was the third MM35-49 runner Mark Howard in 2:41:34. First MM50+ runner and
in 22nd individual place was Steve Tripp in 2:54:36.

Sarah Douglas (9th individual overall) was the first female runner home in 2 hrs 35 mins 14 secs and she also won the Town Garage Queen of the Mountain being the first female runner to Swampy Summit (1 hr 8 mins 21 secs) and to still finish the race. Second female and 12th individual overall was Open Women's runner Dani Nicholson in 2:36:58 and third female was the first MW35-49 runner Bethany Lewis in 16th individual place in 2:43:36. Fourth female home was the third Open Women's runner Sharon Lequeux in 2:58:06. The second MW35-49 runner Donna Young and 26th individual overall finished in 2:55:47 and third MW35-49 runner Jane Guise finished in 3:10:29. First MW50+ runner Toni Walker finished in 3:42:49.

Race the Summit 11km

Second female and 8th overall was Sophie Russell in 1:29:49 and third female and 12th overall was Ann Bixley in 1:34:30.

Third team was Tim Burke (1:10:41) and Megan Burke (1:55:35) for a combined time of 3:06:16.
